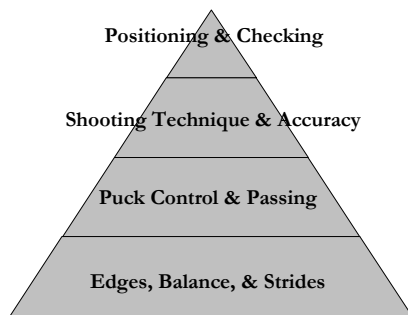

Building of a Hockey Player

At HSDC, we believe skating is the foundation for building a good hockey player. As a player improves his/her skating, skills in other areas of the game will improve and become easier. We try to build confidence in our participants' skating, so the other areas of the game become easier.

The Instructors

Patrick Braglia: Currently coaches the Varsity hockey team at Bethpage High School. He has also coached travel youth hockey at the PeeWee and Bantam Levels. His main focus during clinics is positional play and body-checking.

Timothy Green: Coached all levels of travel youth hockey including Juniors. Currently the Co-Coach for the IceCats Mite team. Tim, also a power skating instructor, teaches players how to use edges properly for maximum speed and balance.

Kevin Smith: Kevin currently is the Head Coach for the Manhasset Middle School and has coached at the travel hockey level as well. He is also a power skating instructor. His main focus during clinics is working with players on stickhandling and shooting.

The Finer Points of Skating

At the Hockey Skill Development Clinic, every player is taught all facets of skating. From proper edge control and balance to power starts and stopping, the instructors focus on making better skaters of all the players. Better skating creates more confident hockey players, and a confident hockey player is a smart hockey player.

The Little Things Always Make the Difference

The positioning in front of the goal, decision making with the puck, and taking an opponent off the puck; these are the little things coaches say make the difference in winning or losing a game. The HSDC teaches players how to do those things well. Time is spent working with players on the ins and outs of playing in front of the net as well as properly giving and receiving body checks. During controlled scrimmages, the coaches also talk to players about the positives and negatives related to their game.
